The Highland Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Decriminalised Parking Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2016

Notice is hereby given that The Highland Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 19, 32, 35, 45, 46,47 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and the Road Traffic Act 1991 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1991 Act") and of all other enabling powers proposes to make an Order entitled as above the general effect of which is as described in the Schedule below.

Schedule

This Order affects all roads containing on-street parking, waiting and loading prohibitions and restrictions within the Highland Area".

To enable all existing prohibitions and restriction on waiting and loading and unloading currently in place in the local government area of Highland ("Highland Area") to be made into a new Map-Based Traffic Regulation Order.

The majority of the existing prohibitions and restrictions remain in place however necessary provisions in respect of civil enforcement under the 1991 Act have been added to the proposed Order. On-street parking, waiting and loading prohibitions and restrictions are also being introduced to some additional lengths of roads and there are some minor localised alterations to existing roads. The locations and lengths of road affected for each of the above can be inspected as detailed above.

The Council has made an application to the Scottish Government under the 1991 Act for the Highland Area to be designated as "a permitted parking area and a special parking area" to enable the Council to enforce on-street parking, waiting and loading prohibitions and restrictions amongst others within the Highland Area and once this is in place the Council's Parking Enforcement Officers will issue Penalty Charge Notices in respect of contraventions.
